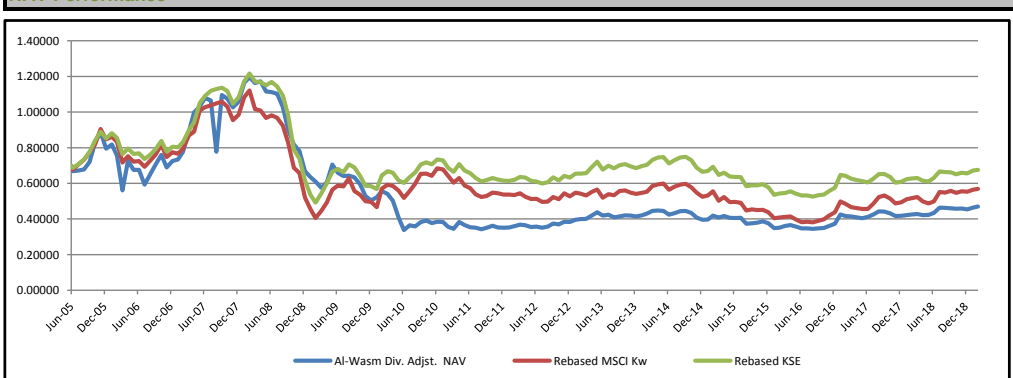

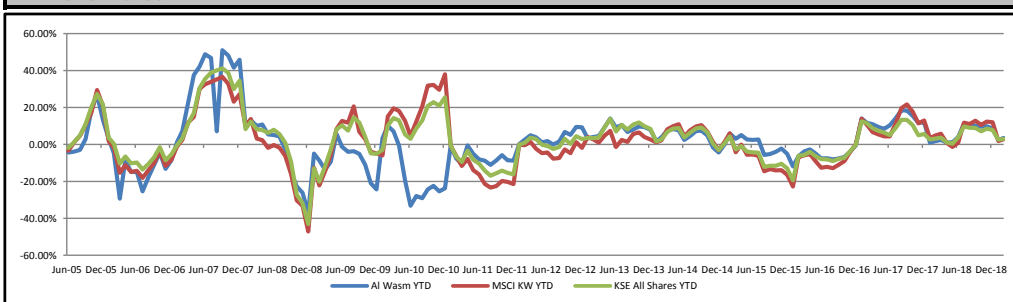

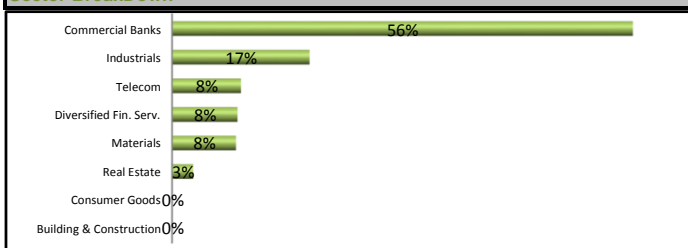

MARKET REVIEW

Kuwait is discussing the creation of a Kuwait-China Silk Road Fund that would invest in Kuwaiti projects related to the Silk City and islands development. China and Kuwait would each be responsible for raising around USD 5bn for the fund. The Asian country would also work with Chinese strategic partners to arrange debt financing for projects, which could give the fund an investment capacity of as much as USD 30bn.

Kuwait's All Share index witnessed an increase by +0.49% with positive contribution coming from Technology +9.26% and Oil & Gas +5.85%.
