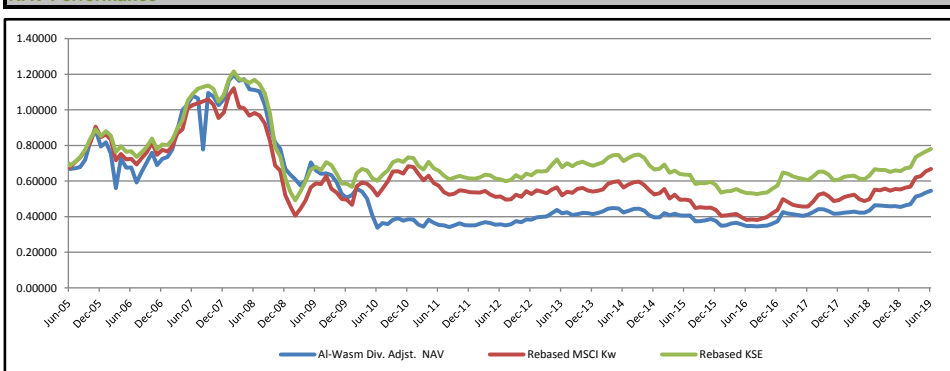

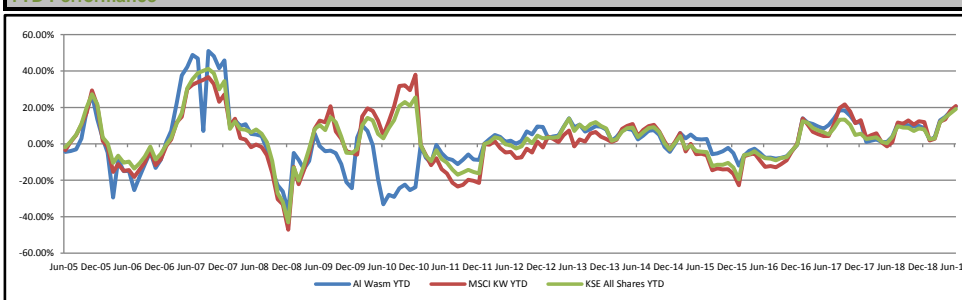

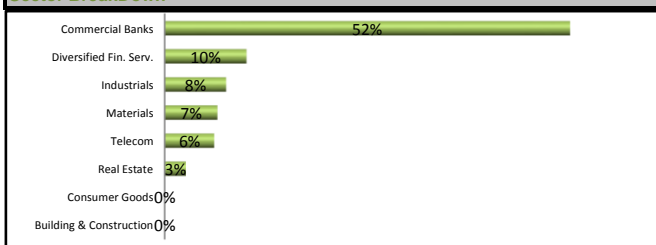

MARKET REVIEW

Kuwait was upgraded to Emerging Markets status by MSCI, the inclusion will be concluded in May 2020 with an index weight of 0.5%. The reclassification of the Kuwaiti market is expected to attract USD 2.8bn in passive inflows. However, the upgrade is contingent on further reforms in the stock market that must be implemented by the end of 2019.

Kuwait All Share index was the second best performer in the region as it increased by +3.81% QTD led mainly by Consumer Goods as it surged by +20.57%, followed by Telecom with +2.627%.
